RESOLUTION

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to move that the House resolve itself into
3 the Committee of the Whole House on the State of the
4 Union for the consideration of the bill (H.R. 9460) to
5 provide for the establishment of the National Foundation
6 on the Arts and the Humanities to promote progress and
7 scholarship in the humanities and the arts in the United
8 States and for other purposes. After general debate, which
9 shall be confined to the bill, and shall continue not to exceed
10 two hours, to be equally divided and controlled by the chair-
11 man and ranking minority member of the Committee on
12 Education and Labor, the bill shall be read for amendment
