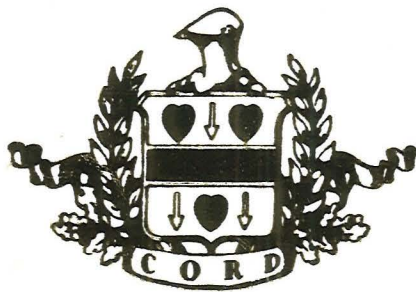

They would be exempt from the new federal automobile legislation on the first 500 automobiles produced annually.
