I would like to urge you to oppose the Department of Transportation, S. 3010. Aviation has made great strides since it was made a separate unit in 1958 by formation of the Federal Aviation Agency. If the Department of Transportation were to absorb the FAA it would put aviation years behind.

I think the bill is vague and does not state any transportation policy for the United States. An example of this is that accident investigation would not be independent of those responsible for operating the system.
