DEAR SENATOR PROUTY:

WE URGE YOU TO OPPOSE AND VOTE AGAINST S.935, THE HART
 BILL. THE PROVISIONS OF THE PROPOSED LEGISLATION PERMITTING
 STANDARDIZATION OF PACKAGES WOULD STIFLE INNOVATION AND CAUSE
 LARGE AND UNNECESSARY INCREASES IN THE PRODUCTION COST AND
 CONSUMER PRICES OF FOODS. OTHER PROVISIONS IN THE PROPOSED
 LEGISLATION ARE LARGELY REDUNDANT OF EXISTING LAW EXCEPT THAT
 THEY GRANT UNLIMITED DISCRETION TO GOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES TO
 REGULATE THE FOOD INDUSTRY. ENACTMENT OF THIS LEGISLATION WOULD
